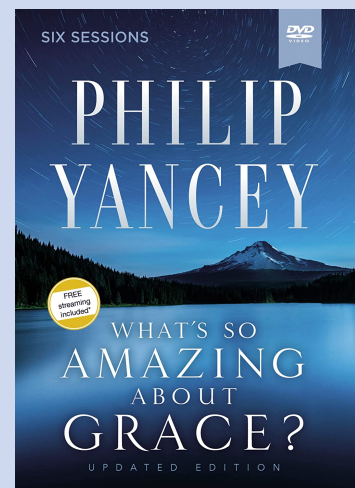


Bible Class II
