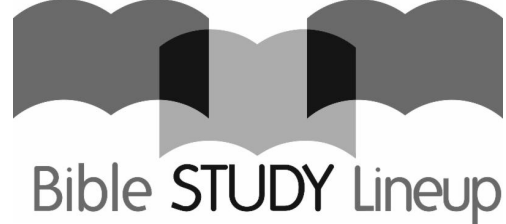

DAY ADVENTURERS TO TOUR THE JEREMIAH O'BRIEN

Join us on **Thursday, March 27th** as we meet at Zion at **9:30 a.m.** and drive together to Pier 35 to tour the Jeremiah O'Brien. This Liberty Ship made seven World War II voyages, ranging from England and Northern Ireland to



South America, to India, to Australia. She also made eleven crossings of the English Channel carrying personnel and supplies to the Normandy beaches in support of the D-Day Invasion. After the war, she was “mothballed” and laid up in the Reserve Fleet at Suisun Bay. Many years and hundreds of volunteer hours later, the O’Brien headed for San Francisco as the only ship to steam out of the mothball fleet under her own power. The O’Brien is approved by the American Bureau of Shipping, certified by the U.S. Coast Guard, and fully seaworthy.
