Bible Class II will start a new six-session video study on The Power of the Holy

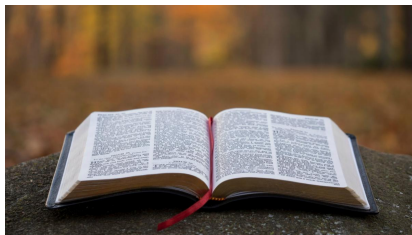
Spirit's Names by Dr. Tony Evans. We will dig deep into the Bible's incredible revelations about the Holy Spirit's unique role.

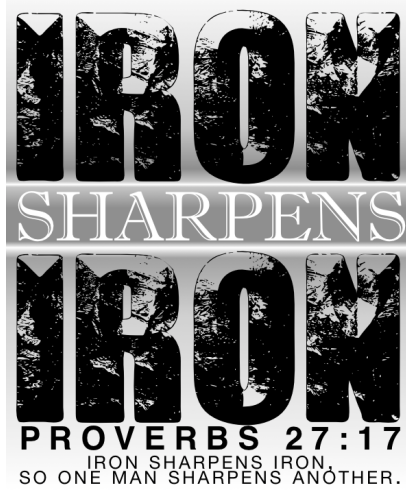
LENTEN PROJECT 2025
