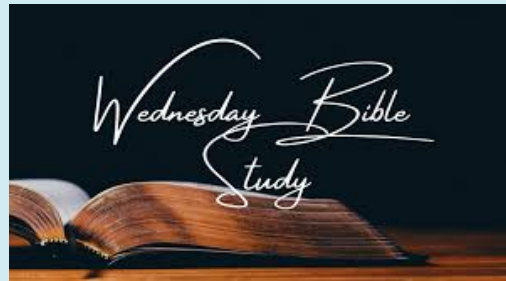
SUNDAY BIBLE CLASS I
