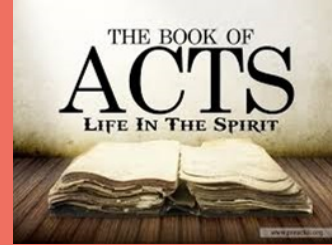


Bible Class II

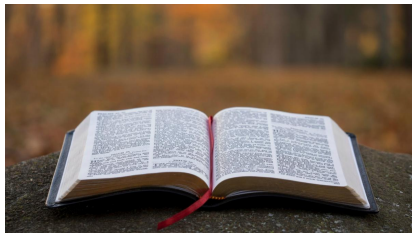


Goal 1. Identify, explain, and illustrate the Holy Spirit and his work through those descriptions and names.

Please come join us in the Conference Room for the start of this wonderful study that will benefit your life.



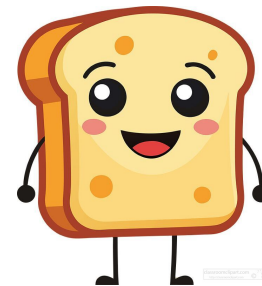
WEDNESDAY MORNING BIBLE CLASS
