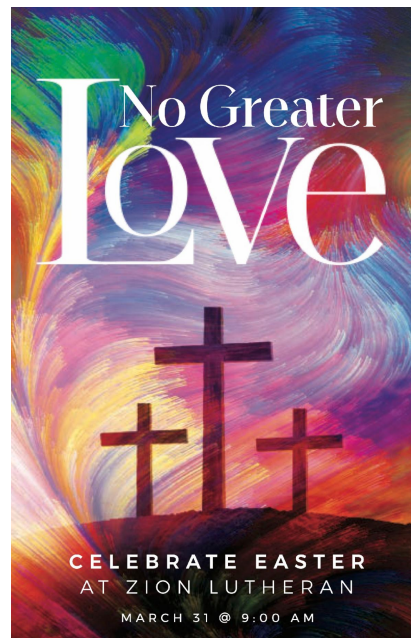

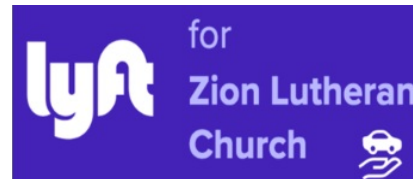
## Confirmation

## Day Adventurers To Visit Filoli

Join us on **Thursday, April 18th** as we visit Filoli Historic House and Gardens in Woodside. The estate boasts 654 acres of beauty nestled along the slopes of California’s coastal range. Originally built as a private residence in 1917, Filoli was opened to the public in 1975. The property is considered one of the finest remaining country estates of the 20th century, featuring a 54,000+ square-foot Georgian revival-style mansion, 16 acres of exquisite English Renaissance gardens, a 6.8-acre Gentleman’s Orchard, and hundreds of acres of natural lands with five distinct ecosystems. Of special interest this month will be the daffodils, tulips, and magnolias in full bloom and bright array.



The cost of senior admission is \$36.00 and we will explore on our own using

the tour brochure provided with admission. (A 90-minute guided tour costs \$75.00!) In order to maximize our time at the Filolo estate, we will enjoy lunch on-site at Filoli's Quail Café.
