SUNDAY BIBLE CLASS I

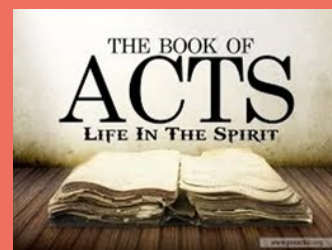

Bible Class II

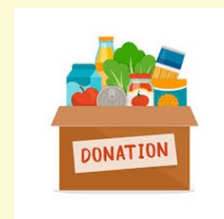
Video Bible Study on ACTS.
