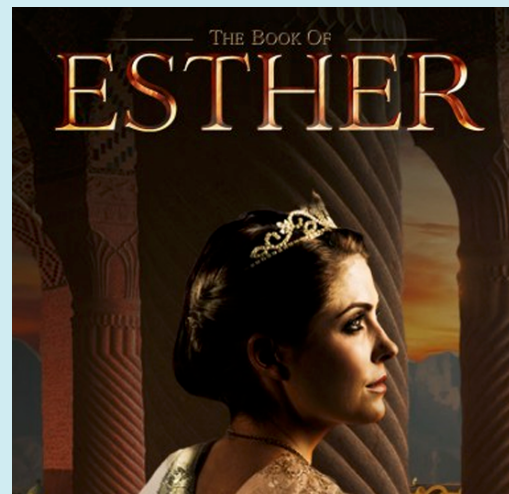

As part of our study, we will also explore the Apocryphal Version of Esther, which includes additional



passages found in the Greek translation of the Old Testament. By comparing these additions with the Hebrew text, we will gain a deeper understanding of the history of the biblical canon and the differences between these versions. Whether you have studied Esther before or are opening the book for the first time, this class offers an excellent opportunity to grow in God's Word, ask questions, and enjoy Christian fellowship.
