The Israelites wanted someone to lead them. There are many Judges and a lot to discuss.




Every session offers an opportunity for a solid study of God's Word and spirited discussion among fellow believers. Come grow in faith and understanding as we explore the book of Judges together.




If you have not participated in any of Zion's Bible Studies on Sunday Mornings, now is the time with the start of the Advent and Christmas Season..


## Movie Night
