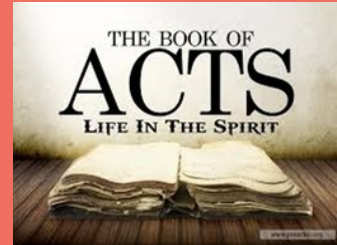
## Bible Class II

**on Sunday, January 26 We will dig deep into the Bible's incredible revelations about the Holy Spirit's unique role.**

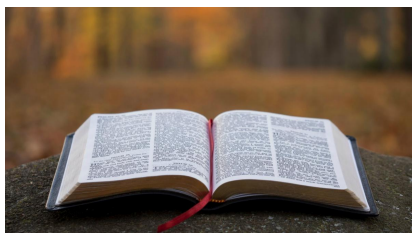


**Goal 1. Identify, explain, and illustrate the Holy Spirit and his work through those descriptions and names.**

**Please come join us on Sunday, January 26, at 8:00 am in the Conference Room for the start of this wonderful study that will benefit your life.**

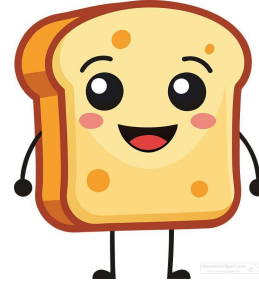


## WEDNESDAY MORNING BIBLE CLASS
